

FOR BELOW GRADE, AUTOMATIC PROTECTION Propane Gas Detector ALARM & GAS VALVE CONTROLLER



4S1-GVC
Gas Valve Controller

The 4S1-GVC is a detector of propane (or other gas), that sounds an alarm and turns off the valve when propane is detected. It is totally self-contained and requires only four Class two connections: 2 to the 24V transformer, and 2 to the gas valve.

The normal application for the 4S1-GVC is to monitor the area where all gas appliances are located (usually a basement utility area), and control a separate gas valve (not part of an appliance) that is located outside of the building.

The alarm/valve actuation is factory set to 10% of the LEL (Lower Explosive Limit) of propane. The 4S1-GVC will also work in natural gas applications.

In below grade propane installations, a 4S1-GVC mounts near each propane appliance, about one foot above the floor, or at the level of the pilot light. For natural gas applications, the 4S1-GVC mounts centrally about one foot from the ceiling.

- ALARM LEVEL: 10% of lower exposure limit (LEL) of propane. (2% by volume)
- ALARM SOUND LEVEL: 88db AT 10 Feet
- GAS VALVE TYPE: Normally closed, Energized by the 4S1-GVC to allow gas flow.
- GAS VALVE CURRENT RATING: Not to exceed 4 Amps @ 24VAC
- 4S1-GVC POWER CONSUMPTION: 1.5VA @ 24VAC
- SIZE: 4½ x 4½ x 2 inches



SPECIAL FEATURES:

- Fail safe: any failure in the 4S1-GVC, or power to it, will result in gas shut off
- DESIGNED TO BE INHERENTLY FLAMEPROOF
- LATCHES IN: Safety feature that requires manual reset (push button on unit) after gas alarm. After power failure, unit resets itself
- CLASS TWO SYSTEM: Low voltage operation
- DETECTS MANY GASES: Propane, Butane, LP, Methane, Natural gas, Gasoline Fumes

If the installation is in an area of frequent or prolonged power outages, an electronic re-ignition system might be installed on the furnace. (Loss of power shuts off the gas with this 4S1 GVC detection system.) Propane re-igniton systems such as those by Honeywell, Robershaw and White-Rodgers are available for propane furnaces.
